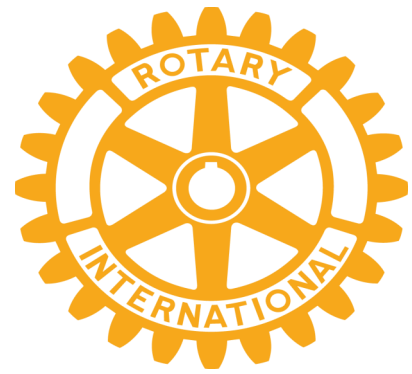

She shared she was in favor of securing our schools to restrict access of individuals entering the school buildings however she also shared she is not supportive of teachers carrying weapons.
